### Attitudes in Mexico

He called for the border to be "a joining line." His visits to the U.S. were filled with endless demands for Mexican citizens illegally in this country. He demanded free health-care, taxpayer-subsidized in-state tuition for illegal's at state colleges and universities, guest worker programs, and amnesty for all that came to the United States illegally.

Former Mexican President Felipe Calderon echoes much of that same sentiment. He strongly opposed the Arizona Immigration Bill, and has said to the millions of illegal Mexicans living in the United States: "Where there is a Mexican, there is Mexico." He wants the United States to ignore our immigration laws and ignore illegal immigration into the U.S., but Mexico's immigration laws are strictly enforced against illegals entering Mexico.

Under the Mexican law, illegal immigration is a felony, punishable by up to two years in prison. Immigrants who are deported and attempt to re-enter can be imprisoned for 10 years. Visa violators can be sentenced to six-year terms. Mexicans who help illegal immigrants are considered criminals. Non-citizens are forbidden to participate in demonstrations or express opinions in public about domestic politics. If foreigners wish to have certain property rights, they must renounce the protection of their own governments or risk confiscation. Foreigners are forbidden to own land in Mexico within 60 miles of land borders or within 30 miles of the coast.

Should the US apply Mexican immigration law against Mexicans in the US illegally?? Why not.
